

You are an NCAA Div I Qualifier if:

- Graduate from high school
- Earn a minimum required grade-point average in your core courses
- Earn a combined SAT or ACT sum score that matches your core-course grade-point average and test score sliding scale on this page (for example, a 2.400 core-course grade-point average needs a 860 SAT)
- Complete the appropriate core courses

2007 Core Course Requirements

Complete these 14 core courses:

- 4 years of English
- 2 years of math (algebra 1 or higher)
- 2 years of natural or physical science (including one year of lab science)
- 1 extra year of English, math or natural or physical science
- 2 years of social science
- 3 years of extra core courses (from any category above, foreign language, non-doctrinal religion or philosophy)

2008 Core Course Requirements

Complete these 16 core courses:

- 4 years of English
- 3 years of math (algebra 1 or higher)
- 2 years of natural or physical science (including one year of lab science)
- 1 extra year of English, math or natural or physical science
- 2 years of social science
- 4 years of extra core courses (from any category above, foreign language, non-doctrinal religion or philosophy)

Notes:

- Students planning on attending a Division-I or Division-II school must register with the NCAA clearinghouse.

Division I

- Must complete percentage of degree requirements: 4 full-time semesters=40%, 6 full-time semesters= 60% which is determined by the DI school your are transferring to.

Qualifier

- Students can take SAT later if they have not enrolled in college full-time.
- Students must complete core coursework in high school
- IF REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT MET, student is still eligible to practice and receive aid but cannot compete, but must sit-out one year in residency

Non-Qualifier

- At least 39 transferable units by the start of the summer prior to transfer and no more than 18 units can be completed during summer school career. Additionally, only 9 units can be completed in the summer prior to transfer.
- If transfer requirements are not met, student is not eligible for practice, competition or to receive athletic aid.

Division II

- Qualifier status does not matter and students can finish core coursework anytime. (Even after High School)

Cuyamaca Eligibility

<p>First Time Participation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be an amateur athlete in the sport of competition. • 1st time competing in intercollegiate athletics at any college • Enroll in and maintain 12 units (9 units towards degree) at Cuyamaca College during the season of sport.
<p>Second Season of Participation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum GPA of a 2.0 • Complete 24 units between seasons (18 need to be toward academic progress) • Enroll in and maintain 12 units at Cuyamaca College during the season of sport.
<p>Community College Transfer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete 12 units at Cuyamaca prior to competition (max 8 units in summer) • Enroll in and maintain 12 units during the season of sport at Cuyamaca College. • File a tracer with Cuyamaca Athletic Department (transcript will be required to determine eligibility)
<p>4-year college transfer to Cuyamaca</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum GPA of a 2.0 • Complete 24 units between seasons (18 need to be toward academic progress) • Enroll in and maintain 12 units at Cuyamaca College during the season of sport.

<p>NCAA Division I</p> <p>Qualifier</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Avg. 12 transferable units per full-time term. • 2.0 GPA (transferable credits only) • Completed 6 units in last full-time term. <p>-----</p> <p>Non-Qualifier</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 full-time terms • AA degree • 2.0 GPA (transferable credits only) • Completed 6 units in last full-time term. <p>-----</p> <p>Qualifiers and Non-Qualifiers must complete 40% of their degree after 4 full-time semesters and 60% after 6 full-time semesters.</p>
<p>NCAA Division II</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Qualifier 1 full-time term or Non-Qualifier 2 full-time terms • Avg. 12 transferable units per full-time term • --OR-- • AA degree • 2.0 GPA (transferable credits only) • Completed 6 units in last full-time term.
<p>Division III</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immediately eligible if never competed • If student competed elsewhere, must meet academic and athletic eligibility requirements had they remained at the 2 year College.
<p>NAIA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 units between last 2 full-time terms

4-2-4 Transfer

<p>Division I</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AA Degree • 2.0 GPA (transferable credits only) • Completed 6 units in last full-time term. • Complete an average of 12 units for each term of full-time attendance that can be transferred toward your degree at the four year school. • One calendar year lapse from the time student left 4 year school
<p>Division II</p> <p>SAME AS 2-4 TRANSFER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 full-time terms • Average 12 transferable units per term • --OR -- • AA degree • 2.0 GPA (transferable credits only) • Completed 6 units in last full-time term
<p>Division III</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If student competed elsewhere, must meet academic and athletic eligibility requirement had they remained at the 2-year • --OR-- • 2 full-time terms • 24 semester units of transferable credit
<p>NAIA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 units between last 2 full-time terms

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
