

4 Easy Steps for New Students

1 Apply for Admission

Submit a FREE Application for Admission online at www.cuyamaca.edu or in the Cuyamaca College Admissions and Records Office in building A300.

2 Send Your Transcripts

If you attended other colleges, have them send your official transcripts to:

Official transcripts are needed to clear prerequisites (see page 56) and to award prior credit for degrees and certificates.

3 Attend Assessment & Orientation

Attend an Assessment session before you register. The recommendations that result will help you in selecting appropriate English and math courses. See page 54 for more details. Walk-in counseling is available if you need further assistance.

4 Register and Pay Fees

Register for classes online or by phone at your registration date and time. Your registration is not complete until your fees are paid.

To Register:

- **New and Returning students** must have an application on file to register. Apply on the web at www.cuyamaca.edu or in the Admissions and Records Office.
- **Registration times** will be mailed to those students with a current application on file by October 29th. After that mailing, registration times will be assigned on a rolling basis.
- You may register at or after your registration date and time.
- **Prerequisites** should be cleared in the Counseling Office before registering.
- **Fee payment** is expected at the time of registration. Failure to pay will result in a hold on your records. No bill will be mailed.
- **Free Internet access** for registration is available in Admissions and Counseling office lobbies.
