



## GENERAL EDUCATION BREADTH REQUIREMENTS for the CSU 2010-2011

The CSU system has established a requirement of 48 semester units in GE as part of a baccalaureate degree. At least nine of the 48 units must be upper division courses. A student attending a community college must complete 39 of the 48 units prior to transfer.

**Important Transfer Deadlines for CSU:** Application filing period is usually done one year in advance.

**Application Period:**

Fall 2011 semester: October 1-November 30, 2010

Spring 2011 semester: August 1-31, 2010 (Spring Admission varies by campus; see [www.csumentor.edu](http://www.csumentor.edu))

**CSU Application Workshops:**

Workshops are typically offered during the month prior to and during the filing period.
