Preparation for SDSU Writing Proficiency As- sessment (WPA)

Transfer students are now eligible to take the WPA once they have received an offer of admission. Students must take the examination during their first semester at SDSU. Students who do not take the examination by the end of their first semester at SDSU will not be able to register for future terms.

WPA scores of 10 or above satisfy the statewide Graduation Writing Requirement and students do not have to take a writing course unless an upper division writing course is required by their major. Students are allowed to attempt the WPA twice within the first semester at SDSU, and must pay the required fee for the examination (\$35) each time it is taken.

Alternative Transfer Options

If you want to live in San Diego during the 2010-2011 academic years, you can:

. Enroll in six units at Cuyamaca College and cross enroll in one upper division course at SDSU. The fee is \$10 per course and you are limited to one course per semester. Stop by the University Transfer Center or visit our website at <http://arweb.sdsu.edu/es/registrar/CrossEnrollment.pdf> to get the cross enrollment form.

Register for additional SDSU courses through the Open University Program. The Open University registration

fee is \$199 per unit. Go to www.ces.sdsu.edu/open.asp for more information about the program.

If you are willing to leave San Diego:

. Apply to another CSU Campus for the Fall 2010 or Spring 2011 semester. Go to www.csumentor.edu/filing_status/ to find out which CSU's are open. Re-apply to SDSU for Fall 2011 in October-November 2010.

If you want to study abroad for a semester or two, you can apply to an open CSU campus and simultaneously apply to the CSU International Program. Go to www.gateway.calstate.edu. To transfer to that university after a year abroad.
