CSU Minimum Admission Requirements

- 60 CSU units by Spring 10
- Golden Four by Spring 10
 - Oral Communication
 - Written Communication
 - Critical Thinking
 - Mathematics



SDSU: TAG for Local Students

- You are in SDSU's service area if 100% of your coursework has been completed at one of the following:
 - Cuyamaca College
 - Grossmont College
 - Imperial Valley College
 - San Diego Miramar College
 - San Diego City College
 - San Diego Mesa College
 - Southwestern College
- 100% of major prep classes completed
- 2.4 GPA or GPA of the major at the time of application
 - www.assist.org
- All students are encouraged to apply even though they may not have above, however, you will have less of a priority.



SDSU Supplemental Application

- Available: December 1 2009
- Due: January 22nd 2010 at 6:00 pm
- Verify your self-reported grade point average and the number of units you will complete by the end of spring 2010.
- Provide information about all lower-division GE courses and preparation for the major courses you have taken, including course titles, number of units, and grades earned.
- Submit online.
 - www.sdsu.edu/portal
- Within one to five working days after submitting application, applicants will receive a Red ID. You must use your Red ID to activate your portal account.

Warning!! You must submit fall grades as part of your supplemental application or you will not be considered for admission.



Helpful hints

- Save username and password
- Have a valid email
- Submit one application, indicate each CSU campus
- Print the CSU Application and Supplemental Application (SDSU only)



Transcripts

- Read carefully when each campus requests transcripts
- You must request transcripts from each campus you attended.
- AP scores must also be requested.
 - www.collegeboard.com
- SDSU will need high school transcripts

- Admissions decisions sent

ALL DUE MAY 1

- All transcripts
- Student intent to register
- \$ 400 Fee

DUE JUNE 30


- Final Transcripts with Spring 2010 grades

 - Apply only once for all CSU Campuses
 - Applies for one academic year

- Also check your email regularly for important notices.

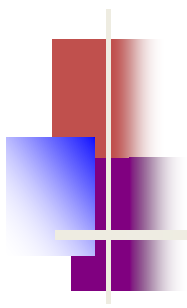
