

TRANSFER AGREEMENT

Between

COLUMBIA SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY

CUYAMACA COLLEGE

And

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA SAN DIEGO, OSHA TRAINING INSTITUTE
EDUCATION CENTER

1. Purpose

The purpose of this transfer agreement between Columbia Southern University, Orange Beach, Alabama known hereafter as CSU, Cuyamaca College hereafter known as CC and the University of California San Diego OSHA TRAINING Institute Education Center known hereafter as OTI-EC is to establish transfer criteria for undergraduate and graduate credit courses earned through CC and OTI-EC's programs that can be utilized toward earning an Associates, a Bachelors or Masters Degree at CSU, an Associates Degree at CC or a Professional Certificate at OTI-EC. The ultimate goal of this agreement is to positively impact the lives of our students via facilitation of credit transfer between OTI-EC, CC and CSU.

This transfer agreement is intentionally written as an open ended document, with the intent of remaining fluid. The document can be modified as needed, i.e. subject to update as courses, certificate and degree programs are modified, updated, created and or implemented. An open dialogue between OTI-EC, CC and CSU will ensure that this transfer agreement remains current and relevant.

2. Background

CSU is an undergraduate and graduate level Institution that is accredited by the Distance Education and Training Council (DETC), which is listed by the U.S. Department of Education as a nationally recognized accrediting agency. As an accredited, degree-granting member of the DETC, Columbia Southern University is also an institutional member of the Council of Higher Education Accreditation.

CSU is licensed by the State of Alabama, Department of Education pursuant to the Alabama Private School License Law Code of Alabama, Title 16-46-1 through 10. Columbia Southern University is an Institutional member of the American Council of Education (ACE).

TRANSFER AGREEMENT

CSU is a title IV school approved for federal financial aid, Veterans Administration Benefits and through the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES), for active duty military personnel for tuition reimbursement.

The OSHA Training Institute Education Center is an official program of the University of California, San Diego's extension program. The University of California, San Diego provides undergraduate and graduate programs as well as public access programs through its Extension Program. The University of California, San Diego is a coeducational state supported institution operated under the governance of the state of California and accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (10 Commercial Blvd, Ste 204, Novato, CA. 94949) (415) 506-0234.

Cuyamaca College is a comprehensive coeducational two-year state-supported institution operated under the governance of the state of California and accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (10 Commercial Blvd, Ste 204, Novato, CA. 94949) (415) 506-0234.

3. The Transfer Agreement

CSU recognizes the professional integrity and academic stature of both University of California San Diego and OTI-EC. CC and OTI-EC does and will continue to offer academic programs and courses that are accredited by the Higher Learning Commission and the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.

Associate degrees offered by CSU include sixty semester hours of general education, major and elective courses. Bachelor's degrees offered by CSU include one hundred twenty semester hours of general education, major and elective courses. Masters Degrees offered by CSU include 36 hours of core and concentration courses.

CSU will accept CC and OTI-EC's courses listed in enclosure 1 as indicated for equivalent general education, major courses or electives. CSU will accept up to 75% of the degree program or a maximum of 45 hours in the Associates program or a maximum of 90 hours in the Bachelors program.

CC will accept CSU's courses listed in enclosure 1 as indicated for equivalent major courses via a Modification of Major upon approval of the department chair and dean.

CC will accept OTI-EC's courses listed in enclosure 1 as indicated for equivalent major courses or via a Modification of Major upon approval of the department chair and dean.

CSU recognizes that both OTC-EC and CC have been in existence for many years. Over this time courses developed by OTC-EC and CC have been created deleted, and modified. CSU will endeavor to provide transfer credits for all courses listed on training certificates and transcripts from both institutions. CSU will not establish a time limit on courses taken at either of these institutions.


4. Commitment

CSU, CC and OTI-EC are committed to serve our students and use technology to facilitate the transfer of students between both institutions. Students participating in the program must meet all criteria for admission to CSU, CC or OTI-EC and comply with all requirements in the awarding of a certificate or a degree.

5. Partnership


This transfer agreement includes a Learning Partnership between CSU, CC and OTI-EC. The benefits of a learning partnership with CSU are: OTI-EC and CC students, employees, graduates, their spouses and children receive a 10 % discount on tuition, a free evaluation and a waiver of their application fee. There is no cost to: CC, CSU, OTI-EC or their students associated with the transferring of credit. CSU will also place the learning partner's name on CSU's website and CC and OTI-EC will place CSU's name on their website.




